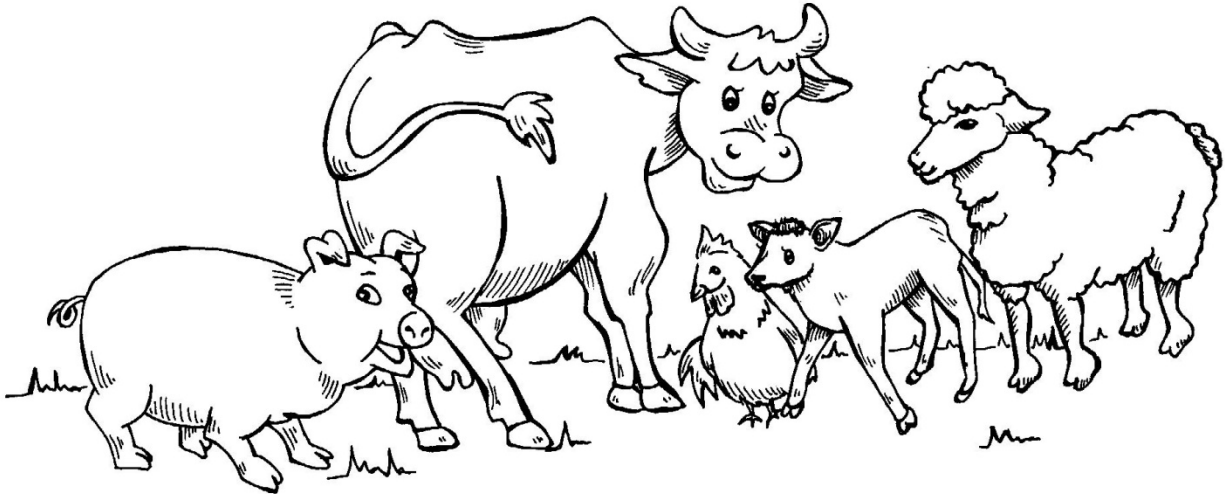


## The King's Dinner
